

Black and White postcards

Project Black and White postcards is a highschool graduation project inspired by the famous slovenian photographer Josip Pelikan. It represents photographs of the architecture, portraits and animals as the Pelikan did it as accurately as it can, at the exact same locations, with exact same equipment and even some people who were photographed by him, but in modern times.

The project had four exhibitions at various places around Slovenia, but the most memorable, was the first one, which held place in Museum of contemporary history Celje (the first three pictures were from there) and lasted for two months. Other places we exhibited were Museum of castle Strmol, library Velenje and at the Cultural centre Šmarje pri Jelšah. Now it has its place as the permanent exhibition in the exhibition room of Photo club Šmarje pri Jelšah.

It was also covered by alot of newspaper houses (the links are in portfolio), as it was the 40th anniversary of the photographers death.
